The church and camp are not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items.



CELL PHONES AND CALLING IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Cell phones are not allowed. We request that all camper calls (incoming and outgoing) be made in the office be for emergency purposes only. If there is an emergency and parents need to contact their student, they may call Lake Geneva Christian Center at 320-763-3680.

MEDICATIONS

All medication, including non-prescription drugs, MUST be turned in at check-in on Monday. This is to avoid sharing of medications. Medications must be in the original container or packaging clearly marked with your child's name. Medication will not be accepted loose in a bag or in a pill dispenser. The name of the camper **MUST** be on prescription medications. Acetaminophen, ibuprofen, aspirin, cough suppressant, antacid, hydrocortisone ointment, decongestant, antibiotic ointment, and antihistamine are available in the nurse's office at camp and do not need to be sent with your child.

CAMP RULES

- Campers are under the authority of camp staff during their stay. They may not leave the grounds unless under supervised camp activities or are on the release list as noted at the time of registration.
- Campers are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times and attend all scheduled functions.

STUDENTS SENT HOME

Students sent home for any reason forfeit their registration fee and it becomes the parents' responsibility to transport them home.

CANCELLATION

Once the registration deadline has passed, there's a \$50 cancellation fee.

LOST & FOUND POLICY

Lake Geneva and Cedar Valley Church are not responsible for items left behind, lost, or stolen. After 30 days, unclaimed items become the property of Lake Geneva Christian Center and may be given to needy families or charitable organizations.

OPEN ADMISSION

No child shall be denied admission to camp or the benefits of the USDA Child Nutrition Programs because of race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap.
